



PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The LL.M is a 30-credit-hour degree that combines a set of core courses with a broad range of electives. Faculty and academic staff work closely with students to tailor an individualised programme of study aligned with their academic interests and professional goals.

CORE COURSES

- Advanced Legal Writing
- Legal Research and Methodology
- LL.M Research Seminar

The core curriculum is designed to strengthen advanced analytical skills, critical reflection, and cross-disciplinary engagement with legal developments.

ELECTIVES AND AREAS OF STUDY

Students select elective courses from across SAHSOL's law curriculum, as well as from approved cross-listed offerings in other schools and departments across the University. Depending on their academic and professional objectives, students may place greater emphasis on research or on coursework while completing the programme.

AREAS OF FOCUS

Faculty at SAHSOL are active scholars whose teaching reflects contemporary legal developments while fostering critical engagement with evolving legal frameworks. Key areas of focus include:

- Law, Government, and Citizenship
- Business Law

A range of elective options are also available in Criminal Law, International and Comparative Law, and Legal Theory.

LL.M THESIS

The programme culminates in a supervised LL.M thesis, requiring students to undertake and complete original legal research under faculty guidance.

LL.M graduates pursue opportunities in:

- In-house legal, compliance, and regulatory functions in the public and private sectors
- Government departments, courts, and regulatory authorities
- International organisations, NGOs, and multilateral institutions
- Policy, research, and academic roles in development, governance, and higher education

The programme also offers strong preparation for graduates seeking to pursue doctoral studies.
